This year there are 606 clubs statewide and 39,474 members. We rank 19th in the state as far as number of members at 227. We are the largest club in Kenosha county and in the lower half of the state. There were 63,735 \$10 discounted trail passes sold, 75,337 \$30 DNR passes and 18,012 Non-Resident sold for a total of 157,084 trail passes.
