Trail Information:

Remember if the trails are closed even if there is snow you will be ticketed. If you are uncertain as to if the trails are open or closed call the snow phones. There is a list of snow phones on our website, the snow phone for Kenosha County is 262-671-4944 and Walworth County is 262-742-2664. Remember to stay on the trails. Going off of the trails are a good way to lose the trails that the clubs try so hard to get and keep. Remember the landowners are doing us a favor. Once we lose a trail we will not get it back, respect there property.

If your not sure where the trails are and where they go you can pickup free Kenosha County and Walworth County trail maps at the club meetings.

Club Trips:

There are a few club trips planned so far and more can pop up along the way. Remember club trips are weather dependent so please check the website for updates as to the status of them. If we have your email you will get club trip reminders and status updates via email. Remember if you are going on a club trip in Michigan make sure you have a Michigan trail pass, the Wisconsin trail pass is only good for Wisconsin.

There are 600+ snowmobile clubs in Wisconsin and we are one of the biggest, be proud of what you have helped build. The clubs are the driving force behind snowmobiling in Wisconsin. Clubs manage and maintain virtually every mile of trail in the state. All club members are volunteers, meaning they're donating their time whether they're negotiating with landowners for trail permission, planning and organizing club events, repairing grooming equipment, marking trails with signs, clearing debris along the trail before the snow falls or grooming the trails. Clubs also purchase the equipment to maintain the trails. Long story short: No clubs...no snowmobiling in Wisconsin.


Can you live in Illinois and get the discounted Wisconsin trail pass?
