Warning About E15:

The Renewable Fuel Standard (RFS) is the 2005 law that requires the blending of biofuels such as corn-ethanol into our gasoline. To meet this government mandate, in 2010 the EPA permitted E15 (fuel containing up to 15% ethanol) into the marketplace, but only for automobiles made in 2001 or after. The use of E15 in snowmobiles, motorcycles, and small engines such as lawnmowers, chainsaws, and leaf blowers is prohibited. It has been proven that E15 will damage these engines, making it vital that E10 and ethanol free gasoline is readily available. Be careful at the pumps and make sure you are getting the right fuel for your sled. The Mobil station on Route 12 in Genoa City carries ethanol free fuel and is one of our valuable landowners. This is what you want to put in your seasonal engines.
